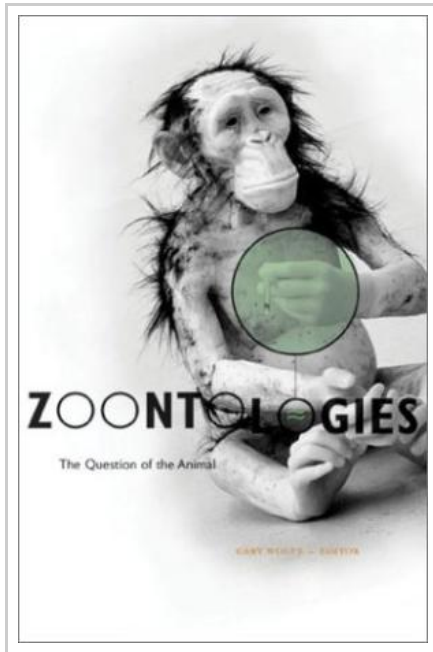




Zoontologies The Question Of The Animal
